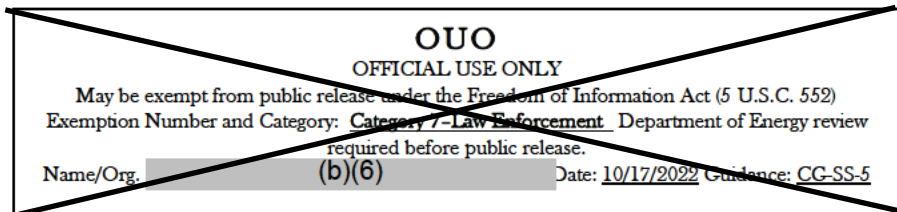

### I. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

On Wednesday, October 5, 2022 at approximately 1000 hours, an employee reported observing a UAS moving over the North west side of Pantex Property from Farm-to-Market (FM) Road 293. After the UAS traveled onto Pantex property from the north, it began moving southwest toward FM 683 approximately 120-150 feet above the ground. (b)(7)(E)

No other reports were received from plant personnel. Both the Protective Force and the Carson County Sheriff's department were immediately notified, but found no activity or evidence of the UAS in the area. The reporting employee described the drone as being black in color and having four rotors with no other distinguishing marks. (b)(7)(E)

This incident has been categorized as an A-Management Interest (AMI) per the Consolidated Nuclear Security Incidents of Security Concern Program Plan, E-SD-0005, Rev.4.

On Wednesday, October 5, 2022 at approximately 1000 hours, (b)(6) a Protective Force employee reported observing a Unmanned Aircraft System (UAS) moving over the North west side of the Pantex Property from Farm-to-Market (FM) road 293. (b)(6) stated that the UAS traveled onto Pantex property from the north, it began moving southwest toward FM 683 approximately 120-150 feet above the ground. (b)(7)(E)

(b)(6). (D)(O) described the drone as being black in color, having four rotors and with no other distinguishing marks that he could identify. (b)(7)(E)

“On 10/05/2022 at approximately 1000 hours, I was the Officer In Charge on Range 1 conducting Live Fire Semi-Annual Qualification activities. (b)(6) and (b)(6)

(b)(6) While waiting on the student to arrive, (b)(6) (b)(6) noticed something in the sky and asked "What is that?". I looked to where he was pointing and observed what appeared to be a "quad" copter style drone, black in color with no discernable markings. The drone was traveling from the north and headed in a south westerly direction directly overhead. It appeared to be 100-120 yards in altitude. (b)(7)(E)

. I lost sight of the object after approximately 30 seconds (b)(7)(E)

. We did not see the drone again."

Both the Protective Force and the Carson County Sheriff's department were immediately notified, but found no activity or evidence of the UAS in the area. While the reporting employee described the drone as having four rotors, no other distinguishing marks were seen. No other reports were received from plant personnel, nor additional UAS activity in sighted. Additionally, (b)(7)(E)

Protection includes physical barriers, access control systems, biometric systems, Protective Force personnel, intrusion detection systems, locks and keys, etc.
