I. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY


On Wednesday, October 5, 2022 at approximately 1000 hours, an employee reported observing a UAS moving over the North west side of Pantex Property from Farm-to-Market (FM) Road 293. After the UAS traveled onto Pantex property from the north, it began moving southwest toward FM 683 approximately 120-150 feet above the ground.

No other reports were received from plant personnel. Both the Protective Force and the Carson County Sheriff's department were immediately notified, but found no activity or evidence of the UAS in the area. The reporting employee described the drone as being black in color and having four rotors with no other distinguishing marks.
